Training Deaf Leaders

Deaf Pah is a free online program of study for Deaf servant-leaders to

- grow in their knowledge of God's Word,
- understand Christian doctrine, and
- become effective Bible teachers, church officers, and caring Christian friends.

"Pah!" is an American Sign Language expression that means "success!" The phrase "Deaf Pah!" affirms that Deaf Christians are able to take the role of servant-leaders in their congregations.

Deaf Pah has been designed for church members and their pastors to work together, as pastors mentor their students and give them opportunities to apply what they learn in their church's ministries. Deaf Pah courses use online ASL videos and downloadable study guides. A few courses use textbooks published by CPH.

Course subjects cover

- General Bible knowledge,
- Teacher training,
- Church leadership, and
- Theology and doctrine.

Deaf Pah courses also provide preliminary training for students who are preparing to enroll in Concordia Seminary's Deaf Institute of Theology.
